

High vowels are articulated in the top part of the oral cavity. The tongue is often high as well.

The vowel in the word "feet" /i/ is tense.

High vowels can be either tense or lax. Say the word "fit," then say "feet." Which word is pronounced with greater constriction of the facial musculature?
